


OPTION 1 — SIDEWALK WIDENING






OPTION 1 — ELEVATION




OPTION 1 - PLAN




option 2 - sidewalk widening








OPTION 3 — SIDEWALK WIDENING

In order to minimize future inconveniences to the public it is proposed to carry out the following maintenance work at the bridges:




Replacement of expansion joint seals to address leakage onto bridge bearings.

Improved seals at access holes to address leakage onto bridge structure.





Miscellaneous concrete repairs. Replacement of traffic barriers.




