WHY MAKE THIS A PRIORITY?


 In 2019, **7 million passenger boardings** were recorded for the Milton GO Line. Today, it is **GO Transit's third busiest line**.

 In 2019, **1.9 million passenger boardings** were recorded for GO Bus Route 21. Route 21 serves the Milton GO line in the hours and direction of travel not served by the train today.

 Today, Mississauga is a regional economic centre, **drawing in over 230,000 workers** daily from surrounding municipalities. In the next 25 years, peak A.M. travel from **Toronto to Mississauga is expected to grow 5x faster** than Mississauga to Toronto.

 By year 2031, the **Hurontario Light Rail Transit** is expected to receive more than **32 million riders** annually and will connect to the Cooksville GO Station on the Milton GO line and Port Credit GO Station on the Lakeshore West GO line.

 In the next 30 years, over **half of Mississauga's population growth** and **41% of employment growth** is forecasted to occur within close proximity to the Milton GO Line.

 Today, **Downtown Mississauga** is the **2nd busiest GO Bus Terminal** on the GO network. In the next 30 years, Downtown Mississauga is **expected to double in size** and grow by 81,000 people and 60,000 jobs.

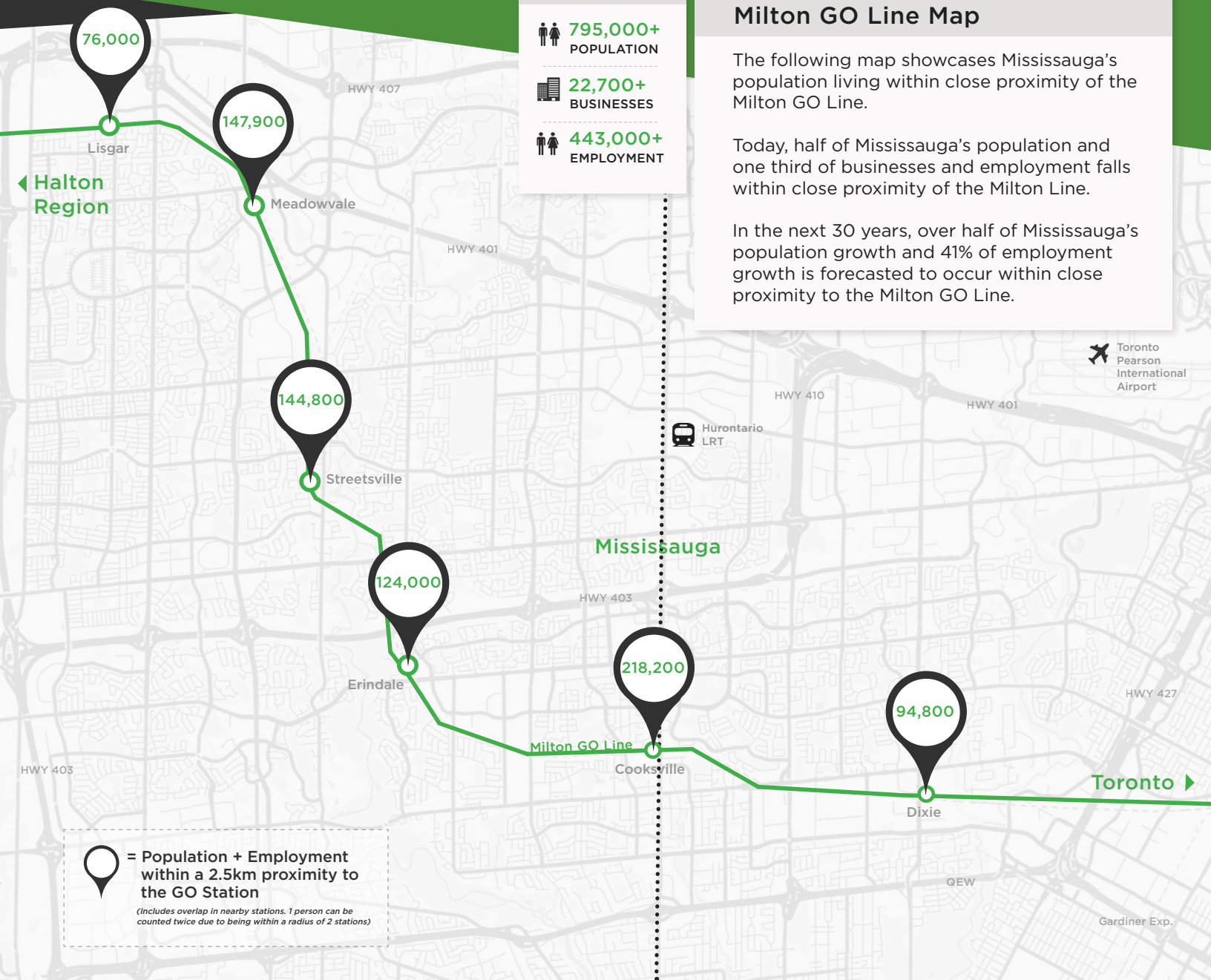

The following map showcases Mississauga's population living within close proximity of the Milton GO Line.

Today, half of Mississauga's population and one third of businesses and employment falls within close proximity of the Milton Line.

In the next 30 years, over half of Mississauga's population growth and 41% of employment growth is forecasted to occur within close proximity to the Milton GO Line.
