

MINIMUM CONTENTS FOR THE SKETCH ASSOCIATED WITH THE ENCROACHMENT AGREEMENT

The sketch must include the following minimum information:


The sketch mast medade the renowing minimum information.	
1.	Must be prepared by an Engineer, Architect or Surveyor in good standing
2.	It cannot be an aerial photograph (i.e. Google Maps and hand drawings are not acceptable)
3.	It must be in high resolution and done electronically
4.	It must be black and white
5.	It must be in legal size (8.5 inches x 14 inches) format
6.	The title of the sketch must say "Schedule to Encroachment Agreement between the City of Mississauga and (insert name of the registered owner)"
7.	Property boundary lines must be shown and identified
8.	Division line between the City property and Applicant's property must be clearly identified in bold Include all Street names in proximity to the Encroachment area.
9.	An arrow or North direction indicator must be shown
10.	A Legend along one side of the sketch must be included to identify the following details:

- A Legend along one side of the sketch must be included to identify the following details:
 - The municipal address
 - Legal description of the property
 - The total Encroachment area(s) (square meters or square feet)
 - Property identification Number (PIN) from the Land Registry Office for the applicant's lands and the City's lands
 - A scale
- 11. The Encroachment area(s) must be cross-hatched and clearly identifiable and must include all dimensions and be labeled as the "Encroachment area(s)"
- 12. The item that is actually encroaching onto the City lands must be identified within the Encroachment area and these include but are not necessarily limited to the following:
 - **Trees**
 - Signage
 - Fencing
 - Retaining/ornamental walls
 - Sprinkler systems
 - Decorative lighting
 - **Stairs**
 - Walkways
 - Accessibility ramps
 - Ornamental (statues, planters, etc.)
 - **Public art structures**
 - Air conditioning units
 - Pool decking
 - Sheds

- Snow-melting and deicing system
- Landscaping (such as vegetation gardens, shrubs, hedges, etc.)
- Proposed tiebacks in support of shoring application and include the Shoring Permit Number and/or the Development Application Number
- Patios
- Awning
- Construction crane swing
- Flag poles
