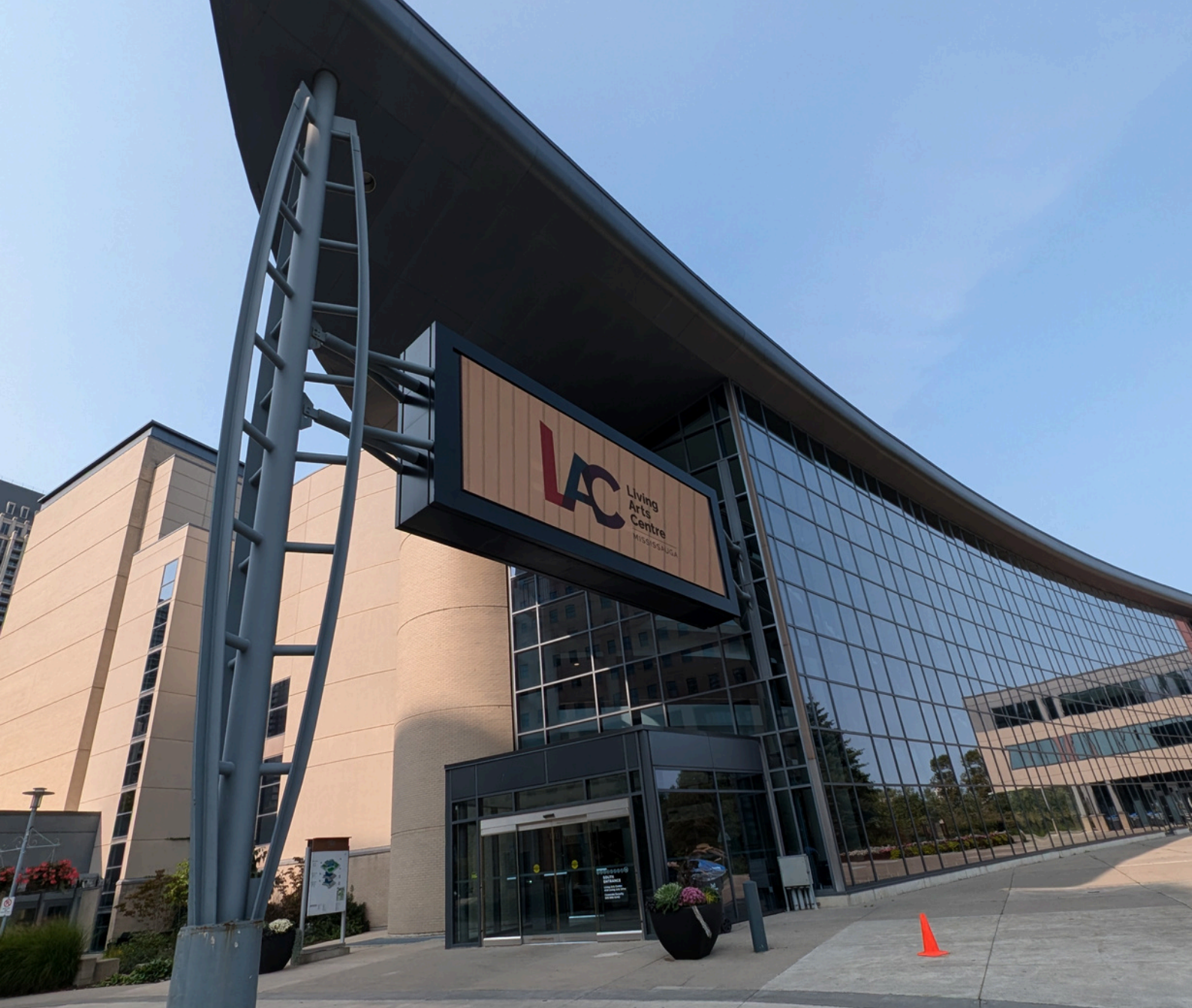

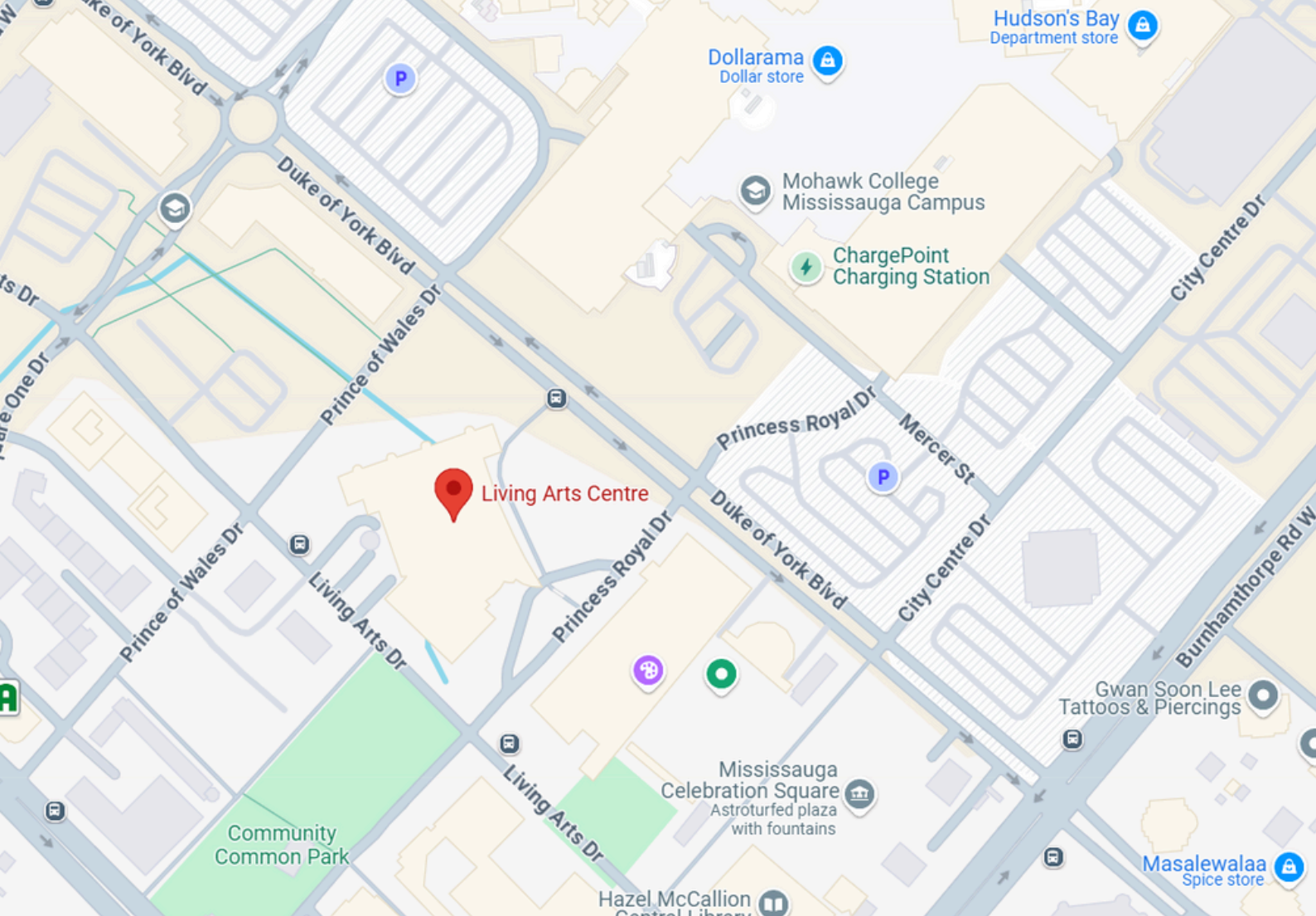


# Living Arts Centre

The concert is at the **Living Arts Centre**, in Mississauga.

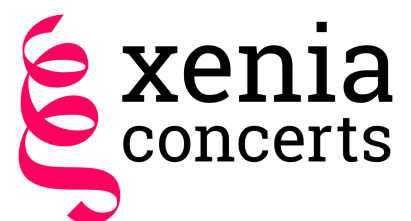




# Living Arts Centre

**4141 Living Arts Drive.**



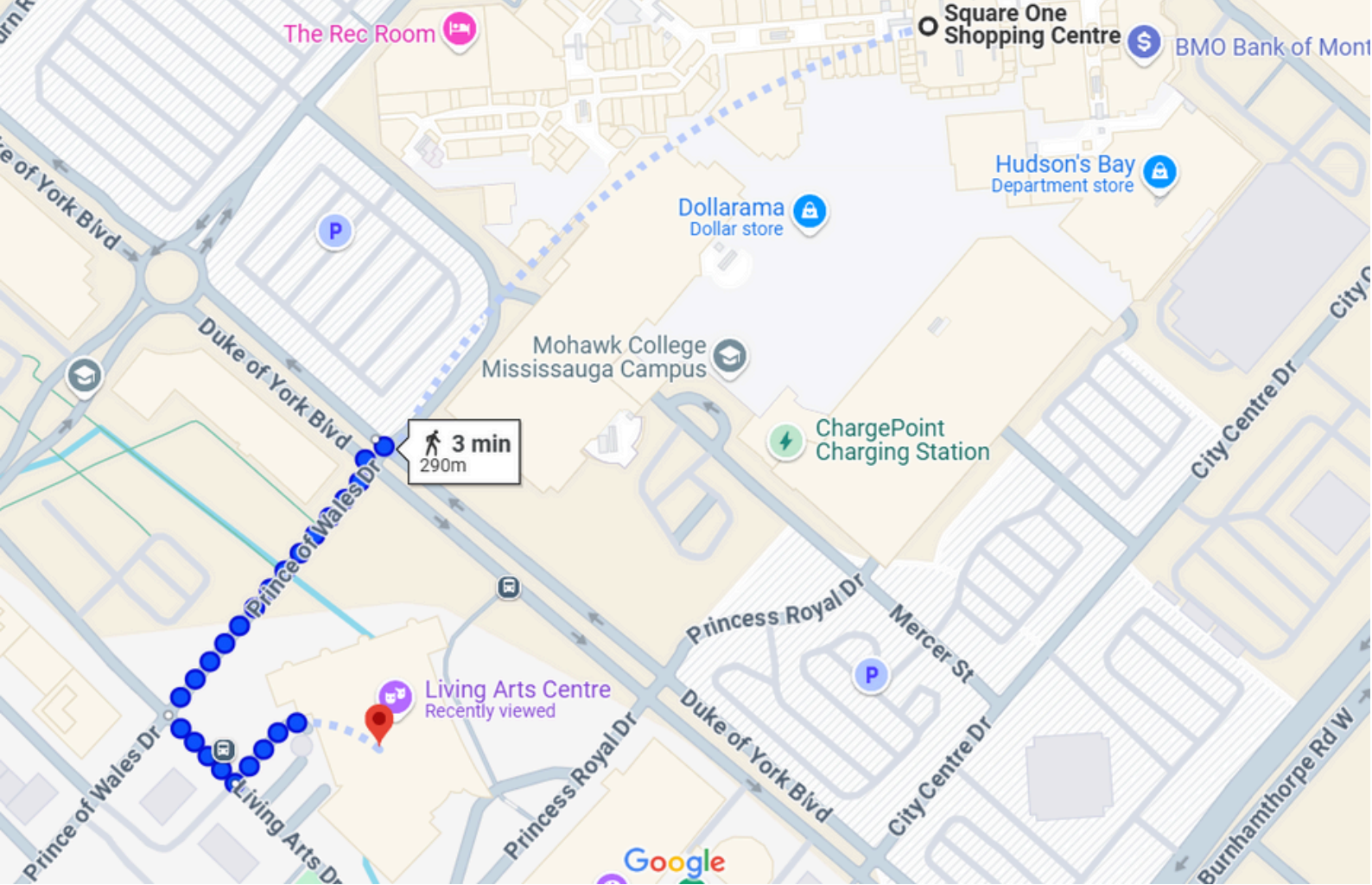


## Getting to the theatre.

---

I can take transit, or a personal vehicle to the theatre. Parking is located below the theatre and is free of charge!

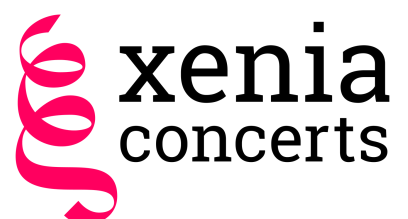




# Transit

Living Arts Centre is located on Living Arts Drive, which intersects with Duke of York Boulevard, Princess Royal Drive, and Prince of Wales Drive.

It requires only a short commute from Square One Shopping Centre and the City Centre Transit Terminal and can be easily reached by local transit, ride-share and taxi services.





## Arriving at the theatre.

---

When I arrive at the South Entrance of the theatre I will have to walk through two sets of doors. The doors are automatic.





## Arriving at the theatre.

After I walk through the doors I will find myself in the theatre lobby. There will be hand sanitizer and masks available for me if I need to use them.





## Arriving at the theatre from parking.

To get to the theatre space from the parking garage, I will need to take an elevator to the lobby. The elevators are marked with signs. The accessibility button for the doors is small, but if I look carefully near the doors I will find it!





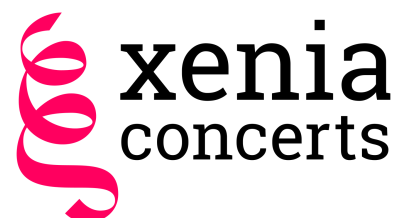

Now that I am checked in, I can enter the theatre through the doors to the side of the registration table.

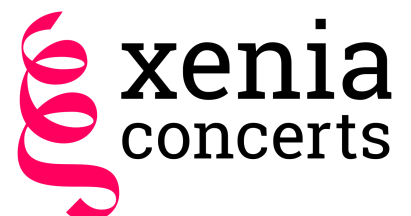




## Finding Seats
