

The Living Arts Centre is located at **4141 Living Arts Drive.**








Getting to the theatre.

I can take transit, or a personal vehicle to the theatre. Parking is located below the theatre and is free of charge!







Transit

Living Arts Centre is located on Living Arts Drive, which intersects with Duke of York Boulevard, Princess Royal Drive, and Prince of Wales Drive.

It requires only a short commute from Square One Shopping Centre and the City Centre Transit Terminal and can be easily reached by local transit, ride-share and taxi services.








Arriving at the theatre.

When I arrive at the South Entrance of the theatre I will have to walk through two sets of doors. The doors are automatic.








Arriving at the theatre.



Once I have entered the lobby I will visit the registration table to get checked in for the concert. There will be volunteers at the table to help me.





There are accessible washrooms located in the lobby of the theatre. Any of the volunteers or Xenia staff would be happy to show me the way if I need assistance.






Studio Theatre
