INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

Qualified Opinion

I have audited the accompanying Form 4: Financial Statement – Auditor's Report Candidate of the Danny Singh Election Campaign (the "financial statement"), for the campaign period March 20 to July 19, 2024 relating to the City of Mississauga municipal election held on June 10, 2024 prepared in accordance with Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

In my opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the *Basis for Qualified Opinion* section of my report, the accompanying financial statement presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the campaign as at July 19, 2024, and the results of its operations for the campaign period then ended in accordance with the accounting treatment described in the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of the various categories of income and expense is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, my verification of income and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the candidate's election campaign records and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to assets, liabilities, income, expenses, or campaign period surplus/deficit.

I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. My responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement* section of my report. Other Matter

Without modifying my opinion, I note that the Form 4 is prepared for the information and use of the candidate and the City Clerk to comply with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and as such, may not be used by anyone other that the specified users of for any other purpose.

Responsibilities of the Candidate for the Financial Statement

The candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed in the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement

My objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statement as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.
