The Grade 4 Read to Succeed (G4R2S) program introduces grade four students to their local public library. The goals of this program are to ignite the joy of reading and encourage students to get their own library card so they can visit the library on a regular basis.

Your visit will include a fun and interactive presentation incorporating book talks and recommendations, library facts and trivia, an introduction to the program (how to participate and collect incentive prizes), a library tour and an opportunity for students to borrow materials. At the end of each school year, we celebrate the classes with the highest participation rates across Mississauga at a special event held at Celebration Square!

Interested? Here is what to do:

- Call or email your designated school library partner to request and book your visit.
- Once your visit has been confirmed, you will receive instructions on how to obtain <u>Library Card Registration</u> forms to ensure that students receive a library card on the day of the visit.

Transportation to the Library - 3 options:

- 1. If your school is within walking distance to a <u>Mississauga Library location</u>, we encourage you to plan a walking trip to visit us. This is a great way for students to get some fresh air, exercise and learn about all the library has to offer.
- 2. If walking is not an option, it is your responsibility to arrange for transportation for your students, to and from the library.
- 3. If leaving school property is not an option, we can arrange to have a library representative visit your classroom or school and bring the program to you.
