- 1. If your school is within walking distance to a <u>Mississauga Library location</u>, we encourage you to plan a walking trip to visit us. This is a great way for students to get some fresh air, exercise and learn about all the library has to offer.
- 2. If walking is not an option, it is your responsibility to arrange for transportation for your students, to and from the library.
- 3. If leaving school property is not an option, we can arrange to have a library representative visit your classroom or school and bring the program to you.
