## Interested? Here is what to do:

- Call or email your designated [school library partner](#) to request and book your visit.
- Once your visit has been confirmed, you will receive instructions on how to obtain [Library Card Registration](#) forms to ensure that students receive a library card on the day of the visit.

## Transportation to the Library – 3 options:

1. If your school is within walking distance to a [Mississauga Library location](#), we encourage you to plan a walking trip to visit us. This is a great way for students to get some fresh air, exercise and learn about all the library has to offer.
2. If walking is not an option, it is your responsibility to arrange for transportation for your students, to and from the library.
3. If leaving school property is not an option, we can arrange to have a library representative visit your classroom or school and bring the program to you.
